

Tell us about Bonnieview Dan. Every long time Montville resident (except, quite obviously, you and John Rosellini) knew that property had things buried underground and had pesticides applied, yet you had the taxpayers pay \$2.2 Million Dollars for a site that we will have to pay even more to clean up. To make matters worse, the people who bought homes there relied on the town's environmental report to assure themselves their yards were clean and safe. How is it that you - someone who spent his entire life in Montville - allowed this to happen?

↳ Dan, you wrote that **“The Lincoln Park water connection as I understand it is NOT required by the state but rather would be needed by future developers”** .... However, as Art Daughtry and Tom Mazzaccaro have pointed out, the Lincoln Park connection is **REQUIRED** by the NJDEP. **Required!** How can you tell us with a straight face that you deserve to be elected when you are so ignorant of Montville's most basic and pressing issues?

↳ Dan, since you refuse to explain it, it is entirely appropriate to question what happened with the two properties which belonged to your family and which somehow moved to the top of the list for Montville to purchase. Explain why the Metro property (64 acres behind Barry's pharmacy), which was a top priority to both the Open Space and Recreation Committees - and which then could have been purchased for about \$2.5 million dollars -was passed over, but your family - the “Harbeson-Grant” properties (which had virtually no development potential) somehow became urgently needed. Voters deserve to know why Montville paid \$5 million for the Metro property in March 2005, \$2.5 million more (all new debt) than they would have paid had it been purchased at the time that your family properties were deemed to be so important.

↳ Dan, tell us why you took more money (\$116,000) in salary and benefits than any other Township Committee member over your last 5 years in office. Explain why you should get the same benefit package as a full time employee?

↳ Dan, Montville's population increased by 50% - to 22,000 people - in the 15 years you were in office. So much for your effectiveness at controlling development. Tell us why you waited until the Ramada Inn application or my site plan on Changebridge Road were pending before you tried to do anything about them. Didn't you have a chance to study the zoning around town during those 15 years?

↳ Dan, Pine Brook residents face absolutely horrible traffic at intersections that haven't changed at all in that part of town since you were in grade school. They've had to deal with two motels that have turned into eyesores during the same 15 years. And GI Salvage is the same mess as the day you were sworn in. So tell us what you've ever done for Pine Brook residents besides raise their taxes?

↳ Dan, The Towaco Valley Aquifer Evaluation Report -which recommended safeguards for our sole source of drinking water - was not adopted for 4 years. Years that you were subdividing your property off Two Bridges Road. Property which recharges the aquifer. Did you put your own

interests ahead of our safe drinking water?

↳ Dan, You didn't bother to attend a Design Review Committee meeting in your last 5 years. You seldom attended the Open Space Committee meetings. And you were on the Long Term Finance Committee for 7 years - and "served" as its Chair for 4 - but there never was even a short term finance plan until Jim Sandham joined that Committee three years ago. Why didn't you care enough to work on the committees you put your name on as you did in getting your name in the newspaper?

↳ Dan, No matter how much you dance around it you know that the Kramer property (now the Dog Park) - would never have become a trucking terminal. You know it was the site of a proposed Kiddie Academy child care center. Did you vote to spend \$1 million of the taxpayer's money to prevent a child care center because you knew John Rosellini was trying to put his own child care center down the street? Was that a payback for his agreeing to spend \$625,000 on your relative's useless "Harbeson-Grant" properties?

↳ Dan, Your last campaign sent out a mailing that claimed "developers own tracks [sic] of land from one end of Changebridge to the other" yet you knew that to be absolutely false. Please name some of those "developer properties". **Can you name even one?** Wasn't this part of your "Fear Factor" to scare residents into thinking there will be more development when you knew that was not true?

↳ Dan, You've admitted taking donations from the principals in Montville Main Associates, who sued Montville to cram 120 townhouses and 34,000 square feet of retail onto Rt. 202. And three years ago you recommended - in fact **YOU INTRODUCED THE RESOLUTION!** - that the Planning Board hear another developer's plan to rezone 27 acres from single family homes to **155 Townhomes!** also on Rt. 202. Don't tell us you don't support new development.

↳ Dan, John Rosellini didn't pay his real estate taxes for over a year - he owed over \$22,000 - yet the Planning Board (which included Rosellini) heard his application for a child care center on Changebridge Road. Why did John Rosellini get favorable treatment? And why did you rush to approve his application when it was so deficient in terms of parking and safety?

**Dan, answer this: Since you are the same as the others who we voted out, then why would we want you back in?**
